BATTERY INCIDENT - CAUSING INJURY WITH A KNIFE

Request for Community Assistance in Identifying Person's Involved

The River Falls Police Department is investigating a serious battery incident that occurred early Sunday morning, July 27, 2014 at approximately 2:08 a.m. The incident occurred on the sidewalk area at the Northwest corner of Main Street and Walnut Street, downtown River Falls, Wisconsin. A male individual used a knife to seriously injure another male individual during an altercation and then fled the scene with two female companions.

The attached photographs are believed to be of the suspect male individual and two female companions as they fled the scene on foot. The Police Department is requesting assistance in identifying these individuals.
