There is not currently an option on lot C, but someone is interested. One possibility for KORC includes an easement for a trail around Lot C. Rick will discuss the options with other KORC group members.


Fees for the new Glen Park pavilion need to be determined, and other shelter fees need to be re-evaluated. Shelter reservations for 2020 will begin at 8:00 a.m. on January 2, 2020. Danke shared photos, seating capacity, and prices for similar park shelters in the Twin Cities and Wisconsin. Rundle showed the riverfalls.activityreg.com online system for making shelter reservations online. Park Board would like to make sure the price is affordable for City residents to make good use of the shelter and seems to feel that full-day and half-day time slots and

pricing is a good idea, and also feels the non-resident rate should be at least \$15 more than the City resident price. Rental fees will be re-visited at the next Park Board meeting.
